



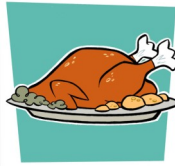

## **PANCAKE BREAKFAST Sunday, January 8th**

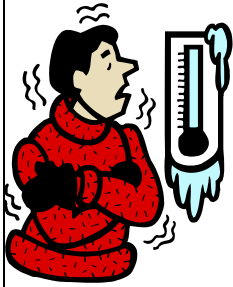

## COLD WEATHER REMINDER



Although the weather is mild now we do know the cold weather is coming! It is the parent's responsibility to make sure that their child is dressed properly for cold winter conditions including dressing them in a **warm winter jacket, snow pants, boots, gloves and head wear**. Please replace broken zippers, shoes/boots with holes in them, or other dysfunctional articles for the health of all of our children! Thank you.

Generally, **below -15° Celsius** (snow and wind conditions considered), children will not be allowed outside to play or the play time outside may be reduced according to weather conditions.

Busing in cold weather: All bus runs will be cancelled when the 6:00a.m. Williams Lake Airport temperature is at -32° C or colder. Bus service may also be cancelled when other severe weather conditions dictate. Please listen to the local radio station for early morning announcements during cold weather conditions.



Radio stations: The Rush (CFFM) 97.5 and The Wolf (CKWL) 570.

*Parents should ensure that their child explicitly understands that they should return home to warmth if there is substantial delay in the morning arrival of the school bus. On days of low temperatures and/or severe wind chills, parents should also weigh the hazards involved in their children walking long distances to the bus or school.*

Teachers will be in attendance at school and students are encouraged to attend on days when the bus service is cancelled. Where there is sufficient enrolment, regular instruction will take place. When there is insufficient attendance, the regular program will not be offered and students attending will receive instructional support or review instead.

## SCIENCE FAIR for ALL Grade 4-7 students

Don't forget that our school Science Fair will be held in February. All students in Grades 4-7 will be required to do a Science Fair project. Students can work alone or with a partner who is in the same grade. If you are working with a partner please be sure you can get together outside of school time to work on your project! Additional information will soon be sent home by the classroom teachers.

Special dates to remember are also listed on page one of each newsletter.

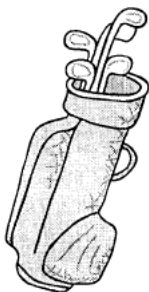
