Dear parent/guardian,

Here are a few important reminders:

Tomorrow, Wednesday, September 9<sup>th</sup> will be a half day. Students may begin arriving at 8:00am. School will end at 11:30 for the primary cohort and at 11:40 for the intermediate cohort. Because School District 27 does not commence tomorrow, there will be **no bussing** until the Sept 10<sup>th</sup>.

Student Health Commitment form:

A copy of the Student Health Commitment Form will be sent by email to each household for completion. It will also be posted on Facebook and the school website. **Please note that students will not be permitted into the school unless the signed Health Commitment Form is submitted prior to (or at drop off) of the first day of school. The Form confirms parents will conduct a daily health check of their child(ren) and that by bringing them to school it confirms that the child is symptom free and fit to be present.** As students arrive to school on September 9<sup>th</sup> the parent/guardian conveying the student to school will be greeted by a staff member and before their child departs to his/her designation, the parent/guardian will be asked to sign a health and safety agreement form committing to your child's health on a daily basis before coming to school.

Masks:

Masks are not compulsory for students to wear at Sacred Heart however we are required to have reusable masks on site. For students who wish to wear a mask one will be made available.

Hot meal program:

For students who have enrolled in the meal program, it shall begin on **Monday, September 14. plan students must bring their own lunch to school on September 10 and September 11.** Ensure your child brings a reusable filled water bottle to school.

There are many other important details that can be found in the Principal Letter to Families dated August 26, 2020.

All of the staff at Sacred Heart appreciate the many concerns that you as a family must be feeling at this time. We will be vigilant, taking every precaution, to assure you that your child will be safe. I am available by phone or in person to listen to your concerns.
